- All partners summarised work developed in last period and the dissemination activities.














• Sisak presented the personalised drones developed related to print 3D parts and a video-game developed related to drones using Roblox software and Blender for modelling 3D objects.





• AIJU will lead the eLearning platform development with the support of the rest of partners. The eLearning platform is ready in 5 languages: English, Spanish, Croatian, Slovenian and Polish. ZS10 and AIJU explained the problems with the Polish server and finally they decided to migrate the platform to the AIJU's server. When the project ends, each partner can migrate the platform to the servers it deems appropriate. But at this moment AIJU offers a stable solution so that stakeholders can register themselves without problems.









- All partners will translate their own courses in their language an in English so that the other partners
  can translate from English. All partner will have the administrative role for their platform and will attend
  the forum related to their platform. English platform will be attended by AIJU.
- Partners discussed about short courses in eLearning platform and about MOOC strategy for disseminating the platform. It will be registered in specific forums, social media, e-twining, etc.
- Partners reviewed the latest indications of the International Conference at Silesian University of Technology as ZS10's multiplier event.
- Sławek Nadolski (ZS10) coordinated students' parallel agenda with some activities assembling drones, programming Mission Planner explained by peers and flying competition in the gym.
- The 8th Transnational Meeting in Spain was confirmed: 3<sup>rd</sup>- 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 (Ibi)
- Waiting expectantly for the International Conference for the next day, the 7th meeting ended.

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
















